A word from God

"The promise to enter the place of rest is still good, and we must take care that none of you miss out. We have heard the message, just as they did. But they failed to believe what they heard, and the message did not do them any good. Only people who have faith will enter the place of rest."
Hebrews 4:1-3a CEV

As we continue to foster our theme of Growing Deep and Going Wide in 2009 and we look more seriously at Going Wide this scripture becomes extremely important. The Apostle Paul makes three statements that stand out boldly. The first is *"The promise to enter the place of rest is still good..."* The promise of salvation is still good. It is not too late for people to get it. Jesus still stands with arms open wide, knocking on the door of the heart, inviting people to come to Him. And the next two statements apply to those who have peace with God. *"we must take care that none of you miss out."* And *"We have heard the message"*. For us to really desire to Go Wide with our witness of what Jesus has done for us, with the message that He will do the same thing for any who ask Him, there must be such a burning desire that not one person misses the promise of salvation. When Jesus came into your heart and you received Him as your savior *"you heard the message"*. But hearing and accepting the message is only the beginning. With that message comes the commandment from Jesus to 'GO AND MAKE DISCIPLES'. May we as a church be found doing exactly that, going into the world with such excitement that people will see what He has done and have a desire to seek a similar change.
