## A word from God

*"... Therefore leaving the elementary teaching about the Christ, let us press on to maturity, not laying again a foundation of repentance from dead works and of faith toward God, ."*  
Hebrews 6:1 *NASB*

When we start our new youth and education building the builders will lay a foundation and everything else will be built upon that foundation. Once that foundation is laid it is complete. The builders may come out and check it once or twice to make sure they didn't make an error or that it is truly as the plans called for but it will never be laid again if it was a proper foundation. God's Word is much the same. The Apostle Paul tells us that we are to lay a good foundation, the same one Jesus gave the Apostles to give to us and that once we have that in place it is time to begin building on the foundation of Jesus Christ. In much the same way Paul wrote to the church at Philippi in Philippians 2:12 that we are to work out our own salvation... this is building on the foundation to the point that we each are growing in our faith and not just rehashing what we have already established as truth. Move beyond the foundation and add to it more building, more maturity in the case of the believer. I think the only way to mature in our faith is to let God show us through the Holy Spirit who is living inside each of us more and deeper truths of God. The next three weeks the message will be on building mature believers. This is vital to every one of us because knowledge of Jesus Christ and His will for each of us, His church, is His plan to impact the world. May I encourage you to grow in your faith as we study this important principle.
